EMTEC awards grant to Ohio company

The [Edison Materials Technology Center](#)'s Core Technology Program awarded a \$283,000 grant to [Iten Industries](#) to explore unique ways to conduct electricity, EMTEC announced Wednesday.

With the funds, the Ashtabula-based company will use nanofiber carbon to produce a mechanism that will manage the conduction of electricity in a new way, said David Swenson, EMTEC spokesman.

The electricity may be used in products to reduce pollutants from coal-fired power plants and boiler flue gases used in the chemicals, pulp and paper industries.

EMTEC is a Kettering-based nonprofit focusing on commercialization opportunities for potentially high-growth materials technology.
