#### EMTEC doles out two grants

The [Edison Materials Technology Center](#) doled out two grants to Ohio companies to support the hydrogen economy, the organization announced Friday.

[EMTEC](#), based in Kettering, awarded a \$324,769 contract to IAP Research Inc., of Dayton. IAP Research will use the money to find technical and commercial uses for the electromagnetic solid state welding process. The company also will determine if the developing technology can be used in other markets.

IAP will work with Elliot Tool Technology, also of Dayton, and Advanced Computational & Engineering Services, of Columbus, during the first phase of the project.

EMTEC also awarded \$260,727 to Cleveland-based Makel Engineering. Makel will use the money to develop an advanced hydrogen sensor system for hydrogen powered transportation.

EMTEC created the hydrogen program to bring hydrogen-related technologies to market. The two grants announced today were selected from EMTEC's call for proposals that would address the needs in hydrogen generation, storage or processing.
