Miamisburg firm receives EMTEC funds

The [Edison Materials Technology Center](#) gave a Miamisburg company \$217,000 to help improve high-tech hydrogen materials technology.

Kettering-based EMTEC granted the money to Precision Energy and Technology through its Hydrogen Infrastructure Program, according to a news release Thursday morning. The funding was available to U.S. companies for product development with commercialization potential in the near future to address the needs in hydrogen generation, storage or processing.

The program's goal is to foster early commercialization of simplified, better performing, innovative and cost-effective hydrogen technology.

EMTEC is a Kettering-based non-profit that develops business and technology strategies through collaborative projects to help get new technology to market.
